1) task (v) 1w: If you task someone with doing something, you give them that job.

- comply, accept, agreement, accuracy, show, percentage, test, **entrust**, fraction.

2) proportion(n) 3w: The proportion is the relationship in size between one part and another.

- **ratio**, show, **fraction**, **percentage**, comply, entrust, accuracy, accept, agreement.

3) criteria (n) 2w: Criteria are a set of principles that you use to judge something or decide about something.

6) consent (v) 3w: If you consent to something, you agree to it.

7) reaction (v) 2w: a reaction is an action that happens because of another action.

- **response**, percentage, accuracy, entrust, **reply**, test, agree, agreement, accept.

8) technique (n) 2w: a technique is a specialized and skillful way of doing something.

- test, accuracy, entrust, reply, **approach**, response, agreement, accept, **method**.

9) validity (n) 2w: the validity of evidence, a statement, a reason, etc. is the level to which it is true or reasonable.

- approach, method, entrust, **truth**, test, **accuracy**, response, reply, accept.
