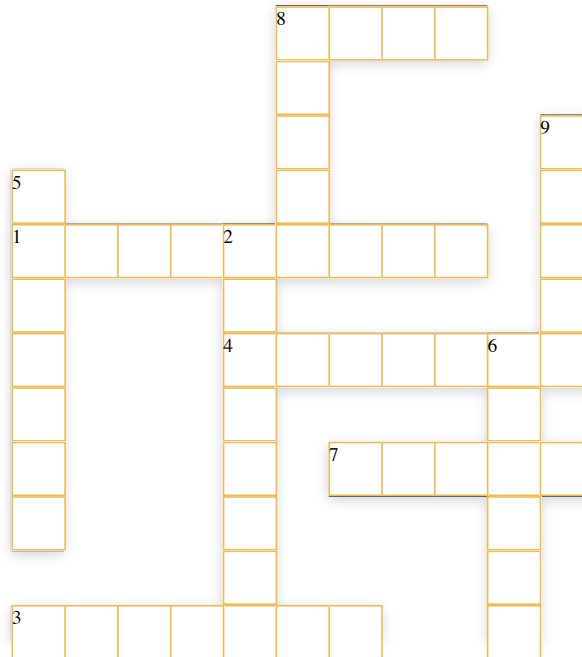


## Crime and Law
