

While When

1: While :

While + past continuous, past simple

Past simple+ **while** + past continuous.

Eg:

While I **was reading**, you **slept**.

You **slept** while I **was reading**.

2: When:

When+ past simple, past continuous

Past continuous +**when**+ past simple.

Eg:

When you **slept**, I **was reading**.

I **was reading** when you **slept**.

Beside – Besides

1: Beside

It is used to indicate location.

Eg: I live **beside** the hospital.

2: Besides:

It is used to indicate addition.

Eg: **Besides** working at the hospital, I also have a job at the school.
