To transform a speech from the direct form to the indirect form you have to remove <u>the quotation marks (")</u> and <u>the colon (:)</u>. Also we need to change <u>verbs</u>, <u>tenses</u>, <u>pronouns</u> and <u>time</u> and <u>place</u> indicators if <u>the report verb</u> (verb outside the quotation marks is <u>in the past</u>, however if the report verb is in the <u>presen</u>t we change everything except <u>the tenses</u>.
