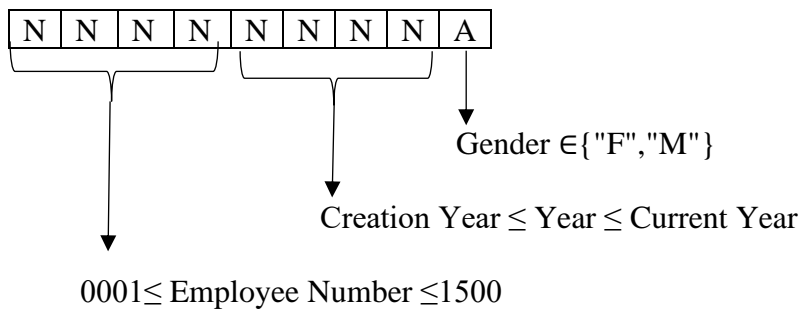

Exercise 1:

a. Employee ID



Type: Articulated Coding

b. Service

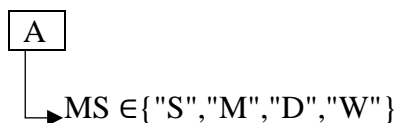


Type: Sequential Coding

c. Marital Status (MS)

Proposed Coding:

- "S" for Single
- "M" for Married
- "D" for Divorced
- "W" for Widowed



Type: Mnemonic Coding

Exercise 02:

City = 4 sectors (phases) = 30,000 housing units

Let A, B, C, and D represent the 4 sectors

$$A + B + C + D = 30,000$$

$$D = 2C, C = 2B, B = 2A$$

$$A + 2A + 4A + 8A = 30,000$$

$$15A = 30,000 \rightarrow A = 2,000 \text{ housing units, } B = 4,000, C = 8,000, D = 16,000$$

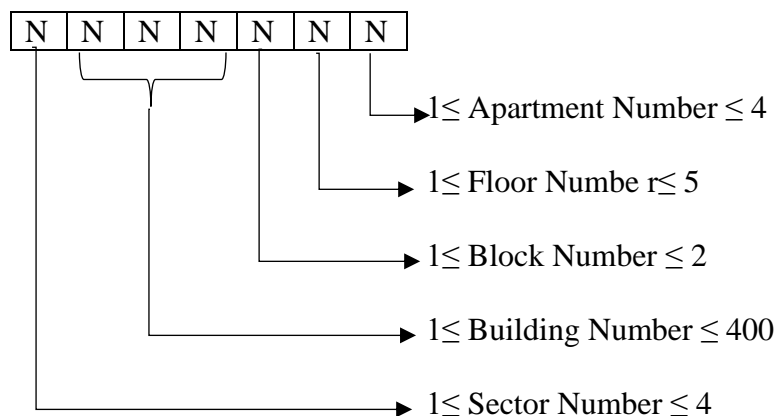
a. 1 Building = 40 housing units

- $A = 2,000 / 40 = 50$ buildings
- $B = 2A = 100$ buildings
- $C = 4A = 200$ buildings
- $D = 8A = 400$ buildings

b. 1 building = 2 blocks

1 block = 20 housing units

1 block = 5 floors \rightarrow 1 floor = $20 / 5 = 4$ housing units



Type: Multilevel (or hierarchical) coding system

Exercise 03:

1. Document Type (DT):

- Use a code to indicate the type of document:
 - 1 for Books
 - 2 for Dissertations
 - 3 for Journals

2. Document Number (DN):

- For books: 1 to 500
- For dissertations: 1 to 900
- For journals: 1 to 1000

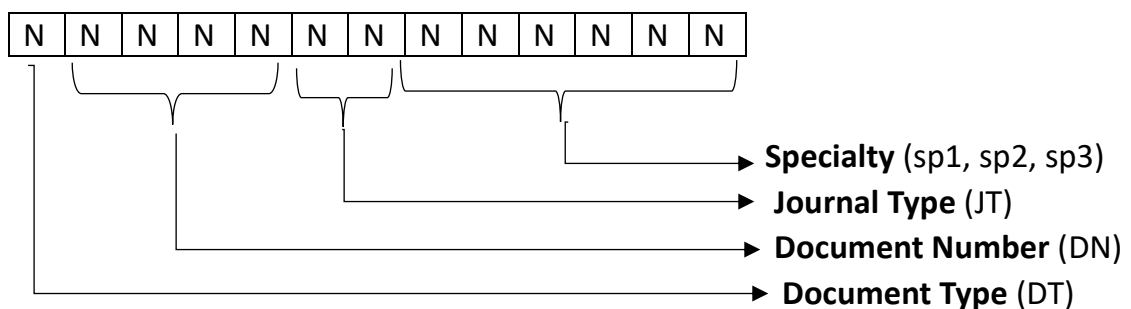
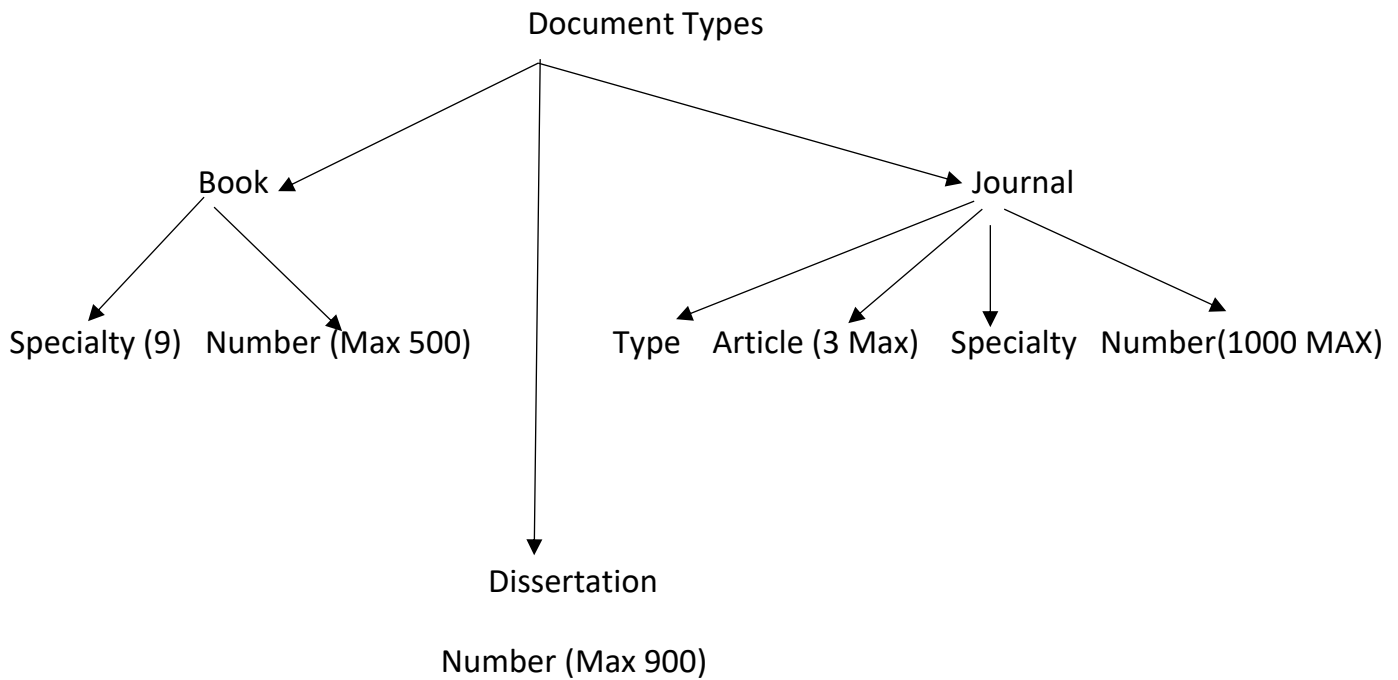
3. Specialty (SP):

- Each document is related to one or more specialties, coded as:

- **SP1, SP2, SP3:** For books, **SP1** is filled. For journals, depending on the number of articles, **SP1** for one article, **SP1 and SP2** for two articles, and **SP1, SP2, and SP3** for three articles.
- Each specialty is coded from **01** to **09**, corresponding to the 9 specialties in computer science.

4. Journal Type (JT):

- Journals are numbered from **1** to **10**, corresponding to the 10 subscribed journals.



Type: Articulated Coding

Note: The "Specialty" field remains empty in the case of a dissertation. Only **SP1** will be filled for a book, and depending on the number of articles in a journal: **SP1** for one article, **SP1 and SP2** for two articles, and **SP1, SP2, and SP3** for three articles.
