Lesson 1: Verb To Be, To Have and To Do in simple present

- To Be (am/is/are)
 - > Am [I]: I am / am not/ am I?
 - ➤ Is [she/he/it]: She is/ she is not / is she?
 - ➤ Are [you/we/they]: They are/ they are not/ are they?

Examples:

- I am healthy/ I am not healthy/ Am I healthy?
- She is tired/ She is not tired/ Is she tired?
- They are active/ They are not active/ Are they active?
- To Have (have/has)
 - ➤ Have [I/you/we/they]: I have/ I don't have/ Do I have?
 - ➤ Has [he/she/it]: He has/ He doesn't have/ Does he have?

Examples:

- I have a healthy lifestyle/ I don't have a healthy lifestyle/ Do I have a healthy lifestyle?
- He has an unhealthy habit/ He doesn't have an unhealthy habit/ Does he have an unhealthy lifestyle?
- To Do (do/does)
 - ➤ Do [I/you/we/they]: I do/ I don't do/ Do I do?
 - > Does [he/she/it]: She does/ She doesn't do/ Does she do?

Examples:

- I do my homework every day/ I don't do my homework every day/ Do I do my homework every day?
- She does sports/ She doesn't do sports/ Does she do sports?
